Regular Board Meeting
Monday, June 12, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 7pm. Present were Chairman Rich Brandl, Supervisors Matt Shinkus and Mary DeYoung, Clerk/Treasurer Karen Teliszczak and several citizens. The minutes were read from the May 8th, May 17th, and May 23rd meetings. Matt moved to approve the May 8th minutes, seconded by Mary, motion carried by 3-0 vote. Mary moved to approve the May 17th minutes, seconded by Matt, motion carried by 3-0 vote. Mary moved to approve the May 23rd minutes, seconded by Matt, motion carried by 3-0 vote.

Agenda

- 1) The liquor licenses and operator's licenses hearing was opened. The licenses that were discussed were for Kip and Debs and for The Boar's Nest. Mary moved to approve the liquor license and operator's licenses for Kip and Debs, seconded by Matt, motion carried by 3-0 vote. Matt moved to approve the liquor license and operator's licenses for The Boar's Nest, seconded by Mary, motion carried by 3-0 vote.
- 2) Building Inspector discussion. There was much discussion on who we want for our new inspector. Matt moved to hire Joe Mesler as the Town's building inspector. There was no second to that motion. The motion failed. Mary moved to hire Jerry Anderson as the Town's building inspector, effective July 1, 2017, seconded by Rich, motion carried by 2-1 vote. Mary and Rich-yes, Matt-no. We will send letters to all concerned.
- 3) Mary moved to approve the Emergency Management Plan, seconded by Matt, motion carried by 3-0 vote. We will send a copy to John Ennis.
- 4) Chief Bruce VanderVeen was present. He gave his monthly report.
- 5) The Planning Commission was re-appointed to new terms.
- 6) Peters Road Bridge update—Batterman wants to bid on the bridge, so they will not do the application for funding paperwork. Baxter-Woodman will do the application. We need to send them a copy of the application from two years ago. This will save them time and us money.
- 7) Shady's Road update—there was a pre-construction meeting. It went very well. We received a time table of the events for the reconstruction of the road.

Clerk/Treasurer—read the Sheriff's report

Public Works Director—priced posts for some bridge repair work on S&D Townline Road, Temperance Trail and Peters Road. Ten foot posts are \$48 each, eight foot posts are \$36. Will be doing shouldering, then the posts. The rim on the mower has broken again.

Mary asked that the July meeting be moved to 6th instead of the 10th. All were in agreement.

The bills were presented. Matt moved to approve the bills, seconded by Mary, motion carried by 3-0 vote.
